1966 INTERNATIONAL HARVESTER C1300

A son's fitting tribute—article from Mike Norman.

After the sad passing of his dad in 2010, Scott Molloy decided to embark on a search for a vehicle to build a tribute to his dad and his trucking company.

Scott knew what he wanted and eventually, after a 3-year search he managed to locate the truck he was looking for. The 1966 International Harvester C1300, had originally been purchased by the Bombowlee/Lacmalac Rural Fire Service (RFS) from new in 1966. The truck participated in many call outs over its service life but was finally de-commissioned in 1998 when petrol powered vehicles were no longer allowed by the RFS.

The truck was purchased by a member of the RFS who added its timber tray sides and the original bumper before it was consigned to a shed on a property near Tumut.

Scott was given a lead through his networks, and with a bit of detective work managed to track the 80-year-old owner down and made him an offer on the truck. Despite being told that the truck was not likely to be sold, Scott's patience paid off when two days later he received a call from the owner accepting Scott's offer.

The next day Scott and his wife set off for Tumut to pick the truck up – that was in 2017. Since then, Scott has done a bare metal restoration on the tray and restored the timberwork on the bed. The cab's paintwork has been rejuvenated and new sign writing added commemorating Scott's dad's trucking company.

The result is a fitting tribute to Scott's dad.
